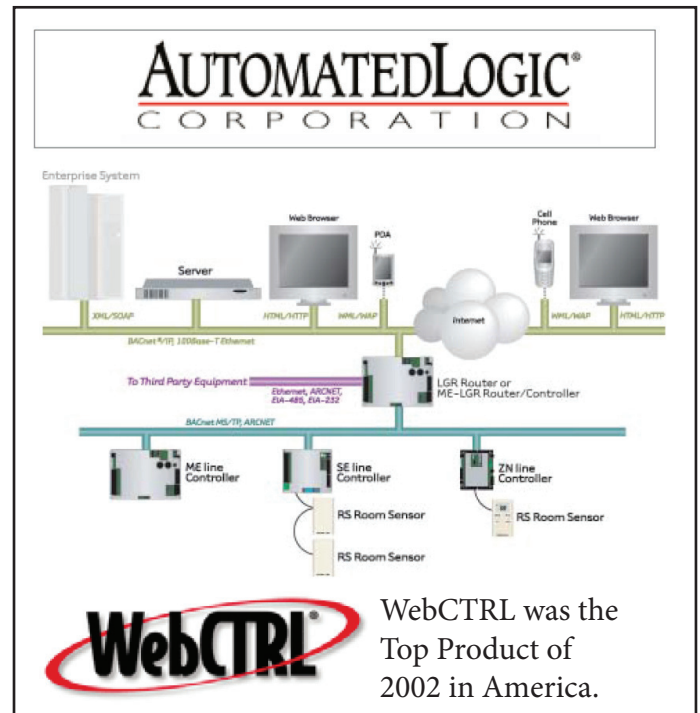


Carrier Has Entered Into Building Automation Sector by Acquiring Automated Logic
